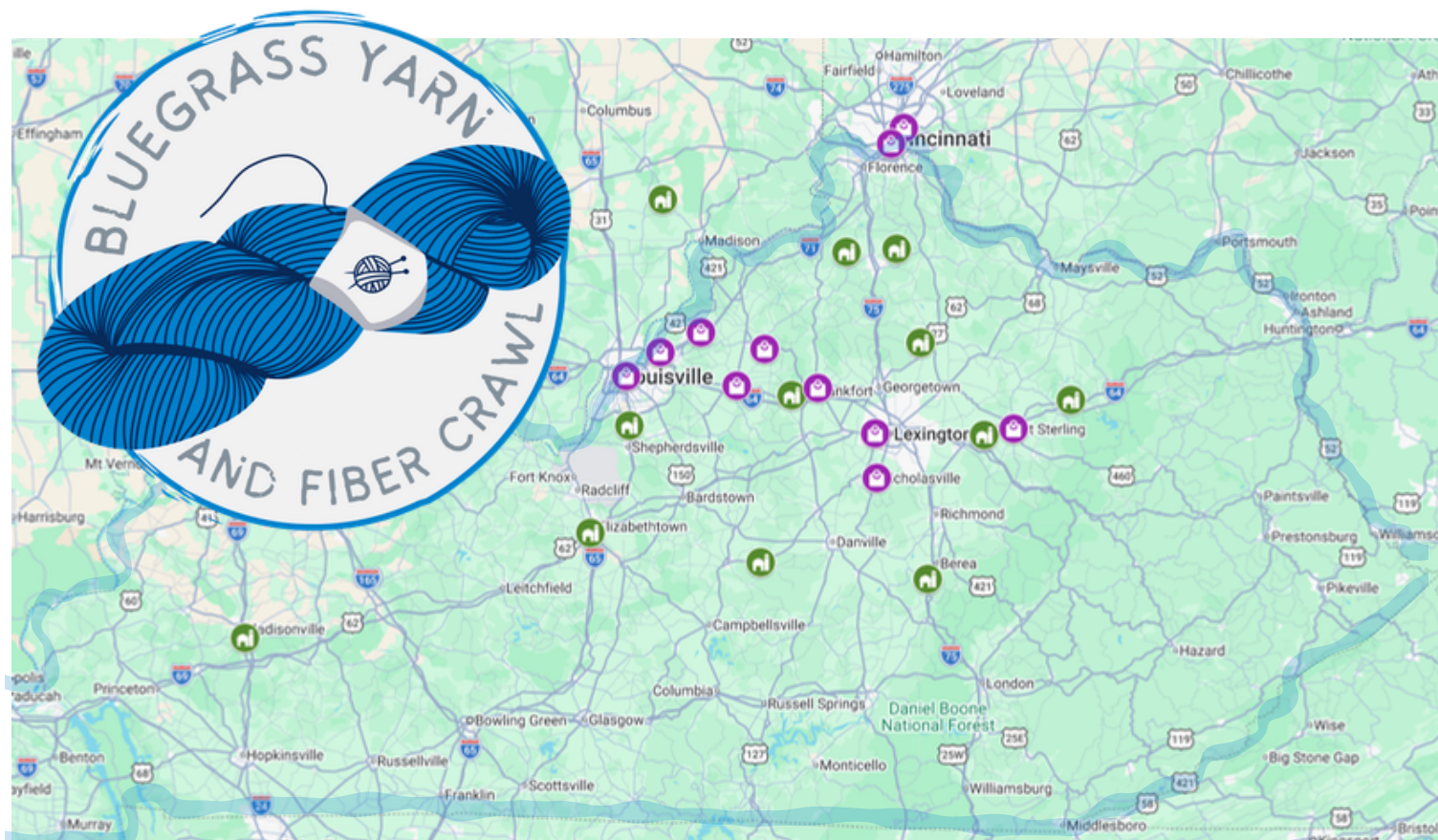


Come travel the 5th Annual Bluegrass Yarn & Fiber Crawl!

Our herd typically numbers around 30 including one or more babies. The alpacas who grow the fiber are near the shop and look forward to treats from visitors!

Our yarn selections include 100% Suri alpaca and blends yarn in natural and hand-dyed colors. I can recommend patterns for those new to alpaca yarn and can provide a free copy with your yarn purchase. I will have roving and raw fleece available. Anyone who makes a purchase during the crawl will be entered in a drawing for a skein of our mill spun yarn and a pair of alpaca socks or gloves.

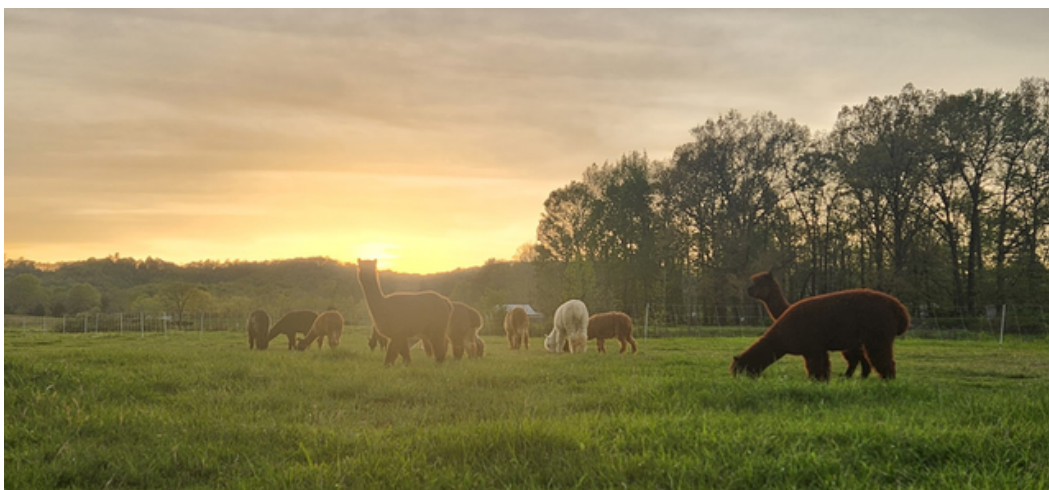
GoodShipp Alpaca Co. is a family-owned alpaca farm located in Bullitt County, Kentucky—just south of Louisville and only five minutes from I-65.

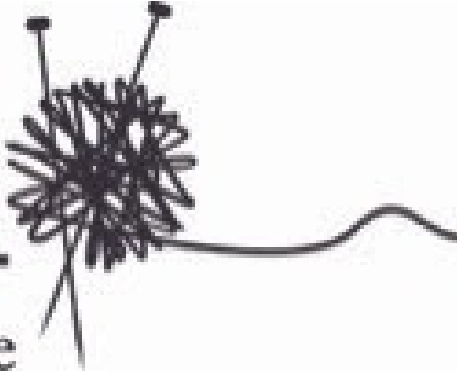
